#### Activities completed in the last two weeks WC 18/01/21 WC 25/01/21

- ✓ Continued data cleansing of Crown Melbourne bank statement packs to overcome errors occurring in translation from pdf file to Excel file. Challenges in conversion and data cleansing include:
  - ✓ Bank statements are not presented in correct date order (some pages jumps to future or prior years).
  - ✓ Duplicate pages were identified for the period of 2018 and 2019.
  - Bank statements are not in the format that can be easily extracted, with columns definitions and alignment that are not consistent across the pack. This requires our team to perform in-depth line by line check to ensure completeness and accuracy in narration and values for our analysis.
- ✓ Continued reviewing Crown Melbourne bank statement to identify patron ID for each transaction.
- ✓ Sent additional data request for SYCO packs and TT reports for the agreed period 2013 2019.

# Activities to be completed next week WC 01/02/21

- ✓ Review Crown Melbourne TA packs against all potential structuring scenarios identified to confirm how cash deposits were matched to patrons.
- ✓ Continuing data cleansing of Burswood bank statement packs. Additional resources have been allocated
  to ensure timely completion of data cleansing.
- ✓ Perform analysis of all cash deposits <10,000 for the following scenarios:
  - Two or more cash deposits of <\$10,000 each, totalling \$10,000 or more in a 24hr period</li>
  - Two or more cash deposits of <\$10,000 each, totalling \$10,000 or more in a 48hr period</li>
  - Two or more cash deposits of <\$10,000 each, totalling \$10,000 or more in a 72hr period.
- ✓ Perform further analysis on additional scenarios as follows:
  - One or more cash deposit of <\$10,000 and one or more wire transfer of <\$10,000, totalling \$10,000 or more in a 72hr period
