Dear Mr Zhou,

Notice of Withdrawal of Licence under Common Law Crown Melbourne Limited ("Crown")

This Notice is to advise you that Crown, pursuant to its common law rights as an occupier of land, has withdrawn your licence to enter in and remain at the Crown Entertainment Complex including the casino at Southbank (the "Complex"), effective from 11 February 2019.

This Notice is issued to you following your behaviour at the Complex on 9 February 2019.

This WOL means that you are prohibited from trying to enter, entering or staying anywhere in or around the Complex from 11 February 2019.

This Notice may be withdrawn at Crown's discretion, at which time you will receive written advice that you may once again enter the Complex, provided that the following conditions have been met:

1. You must comply with all the terms of this Notice.
2. You must not try to enter or stay anywhere in or around the Complex before this Notice has been withdrawn.

If you breach or try to breach these conditions:

- a) Crown may advise the Police, who may take further action against you; and
- b) in addition, Crown may decide in its discretion to issue further notices or take further action against you.

Please note that the expiration date of this WOL has no bearing on the status of your Self Exclusion which remains indefinite.
